New Staff Facilities: A dedicated staff toilet and staff room on the second floor were established to improve the working environment for teachers and staff.

Mini Library for Kindergarten: Set up with new storybooks to cultivate early reading habits and ignite a love for learning among our youngest learners.

Montessori Teacher Training:
